Virgin Galactic is “weeks, not months” away from its first trip into space. The company, **(found – founded – is founded)** by Sir Richard in 2004, promised to be taking tourists on suborbital space trips by 2009; delays and a fatal crash in 2014, which saw one pilot killed and another injured, have pushed back the intended first flight **(multiple – once – only)** times.
